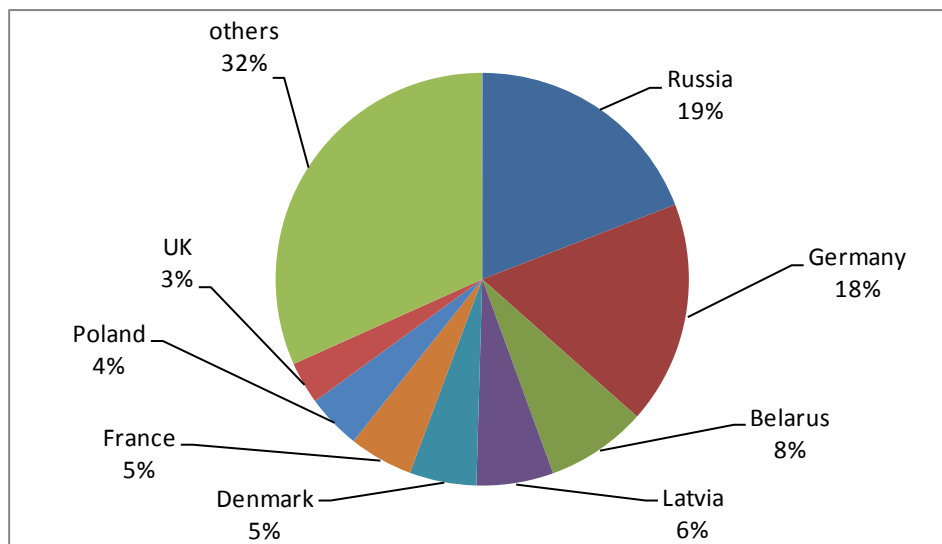

Why choose for Lithuanian services?

Lithuania is one of the European Union's most important transport centers, with about 80 percent of freight being transported through international transport corridors passing the country. Lithuania is the chief transport hub between three major consumer markets: the European Union market (± 340 million), the Baltic Sea Region (BSR) markets (± 110 million) and the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS) markets (± 250 million).

Lithuania has a well-developed infrastructure. Three international transport corridors pass through Lithuania which has the best road system in the Baltics. The only ice-free seaport at the eastern shores of



the Baltic Sea is located in Klaipėda and Lithuania is home to three international airports and a well developed gas pipeline network. Logistics centers are located at suitable locations, close to consumers and industrial activities.

Lithuania has very competitive transport and logistics costs compared to other countries in Central and Eastern Europe. Compared to Western Europe and Scandinavia, prices are remarkably lower. Most companies are dynamic and often not younger than five years. They conduct western business practices complying with the requirements of the European Union and Asia. Modern technologies for stock records and surveillance from shipment to delivery ensure the high quality of services.

Type of activities

Cargo delivery by land, sea and air; freight forwarding; warehousing; custom clearance services.
