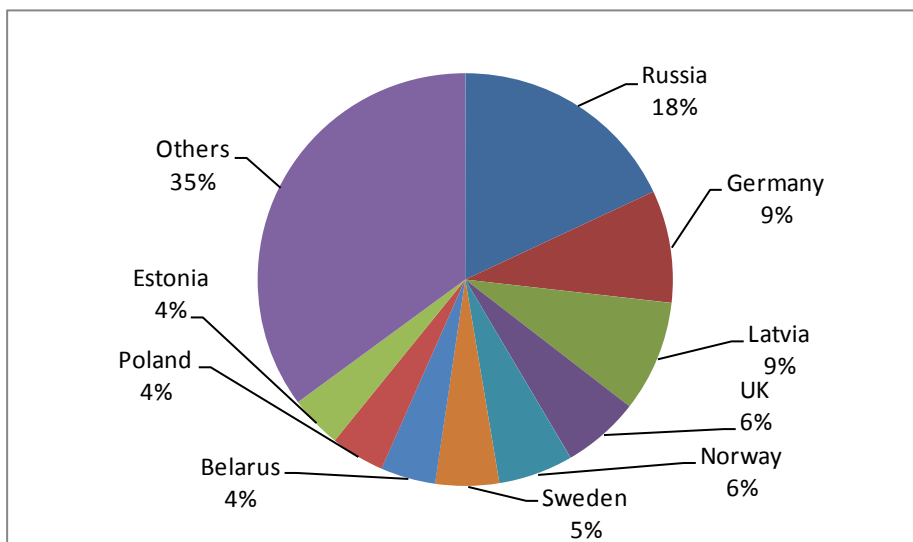

Why choose for Lithuanian products?

Lithuania has a deep rooted tradition in the manufacturing of electronic and laser equipment. Lithuania's electronic and laser equipment industry was leader in its field in the former Soviet Union. Currently Lithuania is an established regional leader.

The Lithuanian electronic equipment sector is dominated by small and medium enterprises which have the flexibility to respond quickly and efficiently to changing market circumstances. Companies produce their



own high-quality products, but also supply major international brands in the automotive, agricultural machinery, defense, medical equipment, offshore, shipbuilding and aviation industries.

Electronic equipment manufacturers experienced a rapid modernization during the last decade, reflected in the implementation of quality management systems and process optimization aiming to produce eco-friendly. Lithuania is home to the biggest technical university in the Baltic States in which 17,000 students are enrolled. The combination of relatively low labor costs and modern machinery gives Lithuanian electronic equipment an attractive price/quality ratio.

The laser and optical component manufacturing sector in Lithuania is firmly positioned at the global market. The success of Lithuanian laser technologies is a result of close cooperation with knowledge institutions which conduct research in the area for more than forty years. Annually, Lithuanian laser manufacturers reinvest 20% of their earnings in R&D activities.
